Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths in both men and women nationwide. To help find this disease at an earlier and more treatable stage, Levine Cancer Institute developed the Lung B.A.S.E.S 4 Life program to bring screening, education and care to those who need it most.

Our support team will travel on the lung bus to your community and offer:

- FREE lung cancer screening for uninsured and Medicaid patients
- Help with quitting smoking for those who need it
- A nurse to help guide you, answer questions and find the support you need

To qualify for a free screening, you must:

- Be between the ages of 55 and 77
- Be uninsured or have Medicaid coverage
- Have a 30 pack-year smoking history (This equals 1 pack a day for 30 years or 2 packs a day for 15 years)
- Currently smoke or have quit smoking within the last 15 years
- You do not need to be a Carolinas HealthCare System patient
